Maths Challenge: We have been working in teams this week to reorder numbers from 0-20. Mrs Thornley then takes a number away while the children have their eyes closed and they have to work out which number has been taken away. Play this game at home with your child but get them to write on a post it note the missing number as this will help with their number formation. There are a few children missing numbers out when counting to 20 so please continue practising this.

Phonics

We have learnt some new sounds this week - ay and oa as well as revising ch, sh, th, ng, ee, oo, igh and ai. We have been learning the sounds they make as well as practising how to form the letters.

ay as in hay

oa as in bow

We have also been working on blending the sounds and reading. Please find your child's writing diary in their book bag. We have been working on writing sentences and using our sounds to spell words. The spelling will not be correct but this doesn't matter! We are trying to encourage your child to write independently. Well done to everyone who completed their diary last week and shared their writing. We are REALLY proud of you!

What have we been learning this week?

We have continued with our 'Space' theme, enjoying the story 'Aliens in underpants save the world'. We made our own aliens in their flying saucers to attach to the giant pants we have hanging in the classroom! These pants are a patchwork quilt of our repeating pattern pants we designed. We made 2D shape aliens, dancing astronauts and designed our very own aliens in the computer room.

On Tuesday we enjoyed the learning street where we got to role play different scenarios in a hospital, vet, police station and building site. We learnt all about different jobs that people do, and in the afternoon we continued the fun designing police outfits, taking finger prints, making glasses and role playing the opticians. We even took care of the school grounds by wearing disposable gloves and litter picking!
