Topic this Term

Term 4 - Will you read me a story?

The children will use Talk for Writing actions to help them to learn and retell traditional tales. They will use props and puppets to support their story telling and begin to create their own stories. We solve problems for fairytale characters and end the topic with a fairy tale themed tea party. Children will be invited to attend the tea party dressed as their favourite book character. You can reuse your World Book Day costume!

We are focusing on encouraging independent writing this term and story telling.

Thursday 7th March - World Book Day. Come to school dressed as a book character.

We will be enjoying our Outdoor Learning sessions throughout the year, so please ensure children have a pair of wellies and waterproofs in school especially for the mud kitchen! Please make sure they are in a **STURDY** bag as the carrier bags have been ripping and items going missing.
