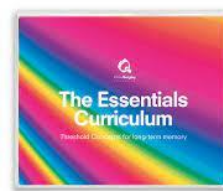
In this newsletter you will find information on what we are studying this term as well as general information and key dates for your diary. As ever, should you have any questions, do contact us via ClassDojo.

Term 2 Learning



Our curriculum is underpinned by the Essentials Curriculum by Chris Quigley, which provides us with a coherent, progressive and appropriately sequenced curricular structure to enable the children to develop subject specific knowledge and skills to prepare them well for the next stages of their education. We also use specific schemes such as White Rose Maths and Jigsaw (PSHE).

This term the children's learning will be as follows:

English	Our focus book this term is The Tunnel by Anthony Browne. We will be writing descriptively, focusing on using similes and expanded noun phrases in our writing. This will include pieces of writing such as a description of a character, a diary and a poem.
Maths	We will start this term by continuing with our addition and subtraction topic. This includes both column addition and column subtraction, with exchanging and regrouping across tens and hundreds. We will then start the first half of our multiplication and division topic, where we will look closely at multiplying and dividing within the 3, 4 and 8 times tables.
RE	Our focus in RE this term is Sikhism. Our big question is 'What is important for Sikh people?'. In this topic, we will be exploring the Sikh religion, describing things that are important to Sikh people, as well as looking at their beliefs about God. We will also be learning about Hanukkah, the Jewish festival, as part of Interfaith week.
History	This term we will be looking at both the Bronze Age and the Iron Age and exploring different aspects of these significant periods of time.
Geography	In geography, we will be looking at physical processes, including learning about rivers, mountains and the water cycle.
Science	This term we have a focus on biology and chemistry. In biology, we will be learning about nutrition. In chemistry, we will be looking at solids, liquids and gases.

Art	We will be looking at Abstract art and artists, with a specific focus on Wassily Kandinsky.
PE	On Wednesdays, we will be learning about dodgeball where we will be developing pupils' understanding and application of when, where and why we need to dodge during a game. On Fridays, we will be learning gymnastics, where we will be learning about moving with control and extension, symmetrically and asymmetrically.
PSHE	Our overarching topic this term is Celebrating Differences. We will be learning about what bullying is, standing up for ourselves and others and learning that we do not use words to hurt other people.
French	This term we will be learning our French numbers from one to ten, learning our French colours, as well as basic greetings and questions.

Additional information

Spellings – these are set every Friday and evaluated on the following Friday. Hard copies are sent home each Friday in spelling books or in reading records, but they will also be posted on Class Dojo.

Reading – Please do read regularly with your child at home. Sign their reading record and help them earn Accelerated Reader awards and House points. We cannot stress how much of a positive impact this has on your child's reading ability.
