# **Term 2 Learning**



Our curriculum is underpinned by the Essentials Curriculum by Chris Quigley, which provides us with a coherent, progressive and appropriately sequenced curricular structure to enable the children to develop subject specific knowledge and skills to prepare them well for the next stages of their education. To augment this, we also use specific schemes such as White Rose Maths and Jigsaw (PSHE).

This term the children's learning will be as follows:

English - writing Our foci this term will be writing to inform, by preparing a report on North America

(historical and geographical) and writing to entertain, resulting in a poem around the

theme of Christmas.

English - reading We are continuing with our daily reading and comprehension sessions, with a focus on

inference, prediction and the use of language to add meaning.

Maths We begin with multiplication and division, looking at factors, multiples, square and cubed

numbers before moving on to our first look at fractions in Year 5. To start we will be finding fractions of amounts, before moving on converting fractions to mixed numbers

and then adding and subtracting improper fractions and mixed numbers.

RE Our topic this term is Incarnation. This is when God sent Jesus to Earth to save people

from their Sins. It starts at Jesus' birth in Bethlehem and ends with his death on the cross. Our big question this term is 'Was Jesus really the Messiah?'. We will also be looking at

Vaisakhi, the Sikh festival, as part of Interfaith week.

History After studying the Maya, the children will develop their knowledge of world history,

chronology and interpreting the past through the topic of 'Aztecs'.

Geography Investigating patterns and places is undertaken through the topic of 'North America'

where we look at population density and growth as well as the physical features of North

America that have shaped these.

Science We have a focus on Physics, learning to understand movement, forces and magnets.

Art/DT

We will be looking at Surrealist art, focusing on Paul Klee, Max Ernst and Salvador Dali.

The children will create a painting using the surrealist style.

PE

Our topic this term is Basketball, where we will be working on improving coordination and decision-making.

PSHE

Our overarching topic this term is Celebrating Differences. This includes looking at cultural differences and how they can cause conflict, racism, rumours and name-calling and types of bullying. The aim is to enjoy and respect other cultures. We also have Anti-Bullying Week this term.

The children will be playing instruments and improvising around the theme of Latin Jazz.

Music

Spellings – these are set every Friday and evaluated on the following Friday. Hard copies are available but they are also posted on Spelling Shed. This app allows the children to practise their spellings and earn points (for the game and House points for school). If your child needs their login details, please let us know.

Times Table Rockstars – we set challenges and fun games through this platform. It is a fantastic way for your child to practise their times table knowledge in a fun way. If they have forgotten their login details do let us know.

Reading – Please do read regularly with your child at home. Sign their reading record and help them earn Accelerated Reader awards and House points. We cannot stress how much of a positive impact this has on your child's reading ability. Books from the school library can be taken home if signed out.
