Term 3 Learning



Our curriculum is underpinned by the Essentials Curriculum by Chris Quigley, which provides us with a coherent, progressive and appropriately sequenced curricular structure to enable the children to develop subject specific knowledge and skills to prepare them well for the next stages of their education. We also use specific schemes such as White Rose Maths and Jigsaw (PSHE).

This term the children's learning will be as follows:

English Our focus book this term is A Bear Called Paddington by Michael Bond. We will be using

this as a stimulus for a variety of writing, including writing instructions, writing a letter

and retelling a story.

Maths In maths we will be starting our next multiplication and division unit, which includes

learning short division and short multiplication. After this unit, we will be moving on to

length and perimeter where we will be learning about meters, centimetres and

millimetres.

RE Our focus in RE this term is Incarnation. Our big question is 'What is the Trinity?'. In this

topic, we will be learning about the meaning of Incarnation and the Trinity and its

importance in the Christian faith.

History This term we will be looking at the Egyptians and the Romans and exploring aspects of

these significant periods of time.

Geography In geography, we will be looking at Europe and physical processes, including the water

cycle and transportation.

Science This term we have a focus on biology and physics. In biology, we will be investigating and

classifying living things. In physics, we will be learning about movement, forces and sound.

| Art | In art, we will be looking at two topics. One is 'A Journey into Space' and will be focusing on the artist Robert McCall. We will be creating our own space art using a variety of medium. We will also be looking at, cityscape art with a focus on the artist Camille Pissarro. |
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| PE | On Thursdays we will be doing dance and will be creating a dance based on the theme 'Wild Animals'. On Fridays, we will be learning tag rugby, with a particular focus on passing and moving to score a try. |
| PSHE | Our overarching topic this term is Dreams and Goals. We will be learning about setting goals for ourselves, overcoming challenges and celebrating our achievements. |
| French | This term we will be learning how to say a variety of animals in French and how to use different articles and determiners in French. |
