Term 5 Learning



Our curriculum is underpinned by the Essentials Curriculum by Chris Quigley, which provides us with a coherent, progressive and appropriately sequenced curricular structure to enable the children to develop subject specific knowledge and skills to prepare them well for the next stages of their education. We also use specific schemes such as White Rose Maths and Jigsaw (PSHE).

This term the children's learning will be as follows:

Balit. We will be taking on the role of someone from this time and writing a diary in their perspective, working on portraying emotions in our writing. We will also be writing informatively, researching volcanoes and the eruption in 79AD and producing non-

chronological reports.

Maths In maths we will be starting our new unit, mass and capacity. We will be learning about

grams and kilograms and the equivalence between the two alongside learning about millilitres and litres. We will then be moving on to our second fraction unit. To start we

will be adding, subtracting and reasoning with fractions.

RE Our focus in RE this term is Kingdom of God. Our big question is 'When Jesus left, what

was the impact of Pentecost?'.

History This term we will be continuing our learning of the Romans and exploring conflicts and

artefacts from this significant time period.

Geography In geography, we will be continuing our learning on national and international

transportation, before moving on to learning about International Trade.

Science This term we have a focus on biology and chemistry. We will be learning about evolution

and inheritance and how humans, plants and animals resemble their parents in many ways. We will then be moving on to chemistry with a focus on fossils and how they are

formed.

Art In art, our focus will be on the Renaissance and we will focus on the artist Leonardo da Vinci and we will be learning about his artistic process and the media and materials he used within his art. PE This term on Thursdays, we will be learning orienteering where we will be learning about mapwork and how to use maps. On Fridays we will be doing Athletics and will be working on running for speed, running for distance, jumping and throwing. **PSHE** This term we will be continuing our learning on Healthy Me. We will be learning about the importance of being fit and healthy, how to recognise safe and unsafe situations and to learn some strategies to keep ourselves safe. We will then be moving on to our learning on Relationships. Music This term, we will be learning the song Bringing us Together. We will be developing our appraisal and performance skills in this unit. French This term in French, we will be learning about the seasons and focusing on the use of the conjunction 'and'. By the end of the topic, we will be able to say which is our favourite season in French.
